 Flatten; only 3-ply; no waxed, no food contamination.

- Junk Mail** Remove any samples.

- Magazines** Remove plastic packaging to recycle; donate to social service agency waiting rooms.

- Newsprint** Loose or place in brown paper bag.

 Computer/copy machine paper, fax paper, envelopes, light-colored office and school paper, etc.; staples, windows, adhesives OK.
- Paper, Low-Grade Mixed** Magazines, junk mail, catalogs, egg cartons, gift wrap, cereal and 6-pack boxes, and all high-grade paper.

- Phone Books** Cancel the ones you do not use.

- Shredded** NOT cross-cut

PLASTIC

- Bottles, Tubs, & Jugs** (Some jars, check with hauler)
 Rinse, discard lids
 NO #6 plastic (most takeout containers & foam).

- 6-Pack Rings** Recyclable as bags/film.

- Packing Peanuts** No food containers or cups.

 Try craigslist, UPS Stores, and other mailing services.
- Plant Pots** Remove all dirt.
 BRING One gallon or larger.
- Plastic Bags** Clean and dry only.

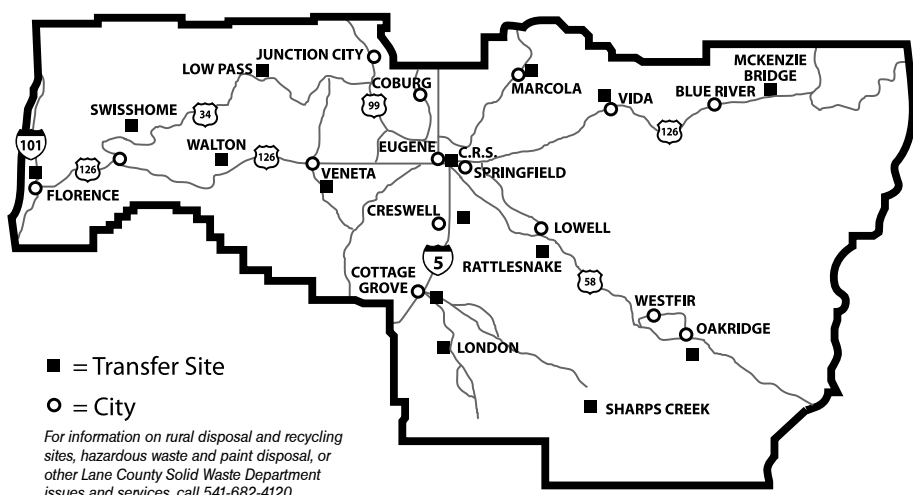
